



THE JIM HENSON COMPANY GROWS SLATE OF FANTASY FEATURES WITH THREE NEW TITLES

“The Boggart” from Susan Cooper, “The Doubtful Guest” by Edward Gorey
and D.M. Cornish’s “Monster Blood Tattoo” to be developed as feature films

Hollywood, CA, February 5, 2007 – The Jim Henson Company has announced the most recent additions to its feature film development slate and live action projects based on beloved fantasy titles fill the list. The company has acquired the rights to “The Boggart” by novelist Susan Cooper (“The Dark is Rising”), “The Doubtful Guest”, the whimsical classic story by Edward Gorey, and the popular fantasy adventure trilogy “Monster Blood Tattoo” by D.M. Cornish. Jim Henson’s Creature Shop, the company’s visual and special effects division, will bring the myriad fantasy characters and creatures of each film to life using a blend of CGI and animatronics. For each project, producing duties will be handled by The Jim Henson Company’s co-CEOs Lisa Henson and Brian Henson, and Jason Lust, the company’s Senior Vice President of Feature Films.

“The Boggart”, originally published in 1993, tells the story of a family from Toronto who inherits a Scottish castle and all its contents...including the gleeful spirit who has been playing tricks on the castle residents for generations. The story is to be developed as a live-action family feature film with Brian Henson (“Muppet Treasure Island”, “Muppet Christmas Carol”, “Farscape: The Peacekeeper Wars”) attached to direct.

“The Doubtful Guest”, a story about an inexplicable creature that shows up unannounced and unwelcome at a family-owned bed & breakfast, has been a favorite worldwide since its debut in 1957. Brad Peyton (“Evelyn: The Cutest Evil Dead Girl”) is attached to direct and Matthew Huffman will write the screenplay.

“Monster Blood Tattoo” is a series of three books, “Foundling”, “Lamplighter” and a third untitled novel, that tell an adventure story set in the world of the Half Continent, a magical Victorian realm where an orphaned boy embarks on a perilous quest to become an apprentice to an esteemed line of monster bounty hunters. No writer or director is attached.
