



'FARSCAPE' SERIES CREATOR RETURNS FOR WEB SERIES

***Rockne S. O'Bannon To Executive Produce 'Farscape' Webisodes for SCIFI.COM
From Jim Henson Company and RHI Entertainment***

San Diego, CA (Comic-Con) – July 28, 2007 – More good news for **Farscape** fans! Series Creator **Rockne S. O'Bannon** has signed on to executive produce and develop stories for the new 10-episode webisode series based on the beloved show. Produced for SCIFI.COM by The Jim Henson Company, in association with RHI Entertainment, the *Farscape* Web series is a groundbreaking endeavor that proves that television series can live again via new digital platforms.

O'Bannon will work closely with executive producers Brian Henson and Robert Halmi, Jr., and SCIFI.COM's Craig Engler, to develop the online show's storyline, which will revive and expand the *Farscape* universe. Each episode is anticipated to run 3-6 minutes in length.

"The characters, creatures, passions, conflicts and barely contained lunacy of the Farscape universe have never stopped. We just haven't had a window into that universe lately to see what's currently happening there. Well now we do. And it ain't calm, and it ain't pretty, and it ain't like anything anyone is going to expect. But it is totally Farscape," promised O'Bannon.

"I am thrilled that Rockne is on board to begin this next chapter in the Farscape saga," said Brian Henson, co-CEO of The Jim Henson Company. *"The army of creative individuals that worked on the original series was crucial to its success. I am hoping that we will continue to reach out to additional members of that team and create a blend of both familiar and new elements in these Web episodes."*

"We're so glad to be able to make this unprecedented deal to give new life to a franchise that was so beloved by everyone at SCI FI and within the sci-fi community at large," said Craig Engler, Senior Vice President, SCIFI.COM and SCI FI Magazine. *"Rockne's involvement ensures that this new page in the Farscape legacy will stay true to the original."*

Screenwriter/director Rockne S. O'Bannon is one of the top purveyors of speculative fiction for film and television today. From the internationally popular science fiction television series *Farscape* to the hit film and television series *Alien Nation*, to SCI FI's blockbuster 2005 miniseries *The Triangle*, he has pushed the limits of imagination on both the big and small screens.

A hit with both critics and fans, *Farscape* has been widely recognized as one of the greatest sci-fi series in television history.
